

Handsome Molly Chords by Doc Watson

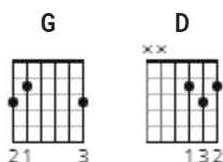
Description: This tab is based on the studio recorded version (<https://youtu.be/hLeBnuTB6X8>).
