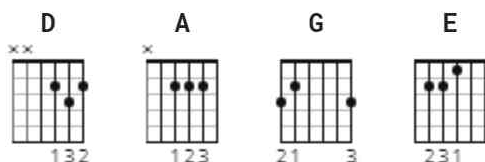


Let The Mermaids Flirt With Me Chords by Mississippi John Hurt
