Intro: |A |A / |E |B |B / |A

Verse 1:

2 beats
|A |A / |E |E
I went out late one night,
2 beats
|B |B / |A |A
The moon and stars were shining bright
2 beats
|A |B / |E |E
A storm come up and the trees come down,
2 beats
|E |C#m / |A |A
I tell you boys I was water bound

Verse 2:

|A |A / |E |E |B |B / |A |A
Waterbound on a stranger's shore River rising to my door
|A |B / |E |E |E |C#m / |A |A
Carried my home to the field be-low I'm water bound, no-where to go.

Verse 3:

|A |A / |E |E
Carved my name on an old barn wall
|B |B / |A |A
Or no-one would know I was there at all
|A |B / |E |E
Stable's dry on a winter's night
|E |Bm / |A |A
If you turn your head you can see the light.
